JOURNEY STAKES LARGE LAND PACKAGE IN SAN BLAS, SINALOA

Vancouver, B.C. – JOURNEY RESOURCES CORP. (“Journey” or the “Company”) is pleased to provide an update on current exploration outside of its Charay gold-silver deposit located near (35 km northeast) the town of Los Mochis, Sinaloa state, Mexico.

In 2008, the Company acquired an option on the Charay property, which comprises three mineral concessions covering approximately 380 hectares located in the San Blas region of northern Sinaloa State, Mexico, and approximately 250 km northwest of the state capital Culiacan. In 2005, Vane Minerals Group drilled 27 shallow holes on the property, nineteen of which targeted and intersected mineralized epithermal quartz veining along a 240 meter strike length of the El Padre vein. Geologic mapping, geochemical sampling and review of previous drilling has identified a number of mineralized trends that remain open along strike and at depth.

The Company has acquired over 11,000 hectares of mineral concessions contiguous to the Charay property, mostly along the strike projections of the epithermal vein system found at Charay. Given the extent of untested ground with similar indicators and structural fabric to that of the Charay property, there is potential to expand the known high-grade mineralization of the project.

The qualified person for the project, Phil Van Angeren, P.Geol, has prepared a 43-101 compliant report for Journey. This report is available for viewing on the company website (www.journeyresourcescorp.com). “This new land package represents a significant step up in allowing Journey the opportunity to add to the El Padre mineralization, and to discover new mineralized zones.” ”

The Company is currently exploring four advanced exploration-stage projects; the Musgrove Gold Project, the Charay Gold Project, the Vianey Mine Silver Project and the Silver Mountain Project. The Musgrove Project is a prospect for a disseminated gold bulk-tonnage surface project similar to the Beartrack Mine, a nearby former gold producer. The Charay property consists of concessions totaling 380 hectares, located in Sinaloa, Mexico. The Vianey Mine Project consists of concessions totaling 5,022 hectares in Guerrero State west of Mexico City, Mexico. In addition, the Company owns 100% right, title and interest in and to certain mining claims comprising the Silver Mountain Property in Lima, Peru. The Silver Mountain Property is an advanced stage exploration property covering approximately 1,684 hectares, located approximately 75 kilometers east of Lima City and 50 kilometers south of Peru Copper’s Toromocho property and Pan American Silver’s Morococha Mine.
